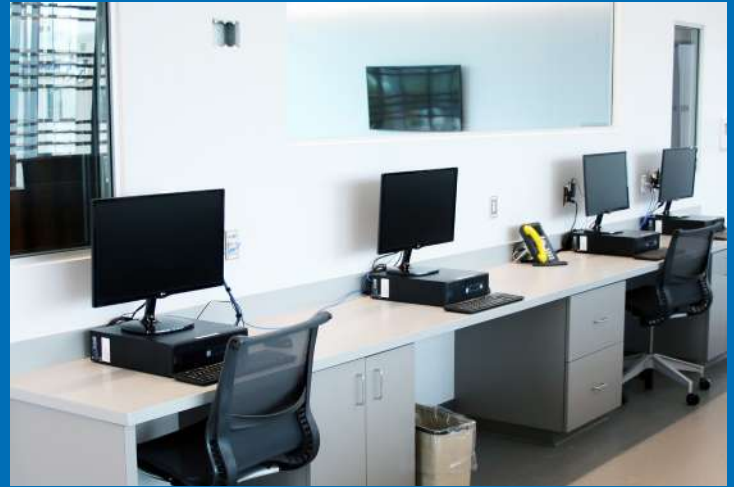
**SOLUTION**

Seventeen mock exam rooms, six simulation labs, a mock home environment, and over 40 study rooms for students to use at their convenience.
